

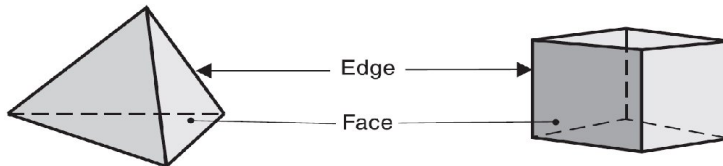

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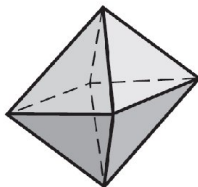

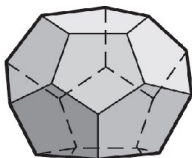


(a) Tetrahedron

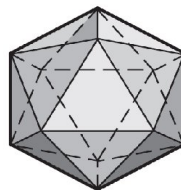
(b) Cube



(c) Octahedron

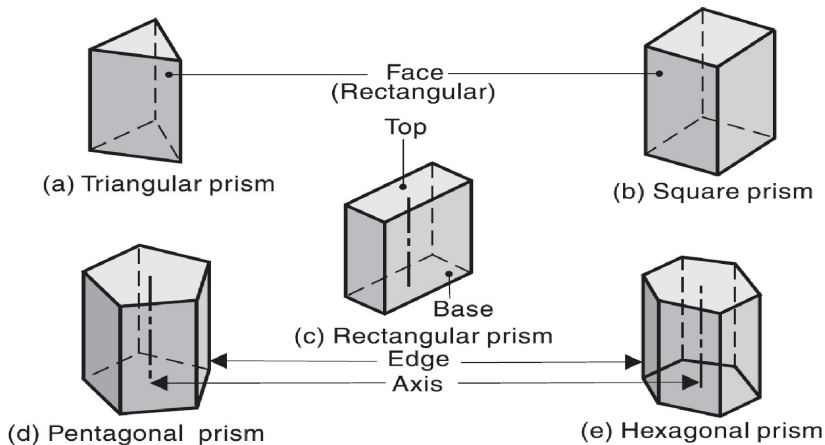


(d) Dodecahedron

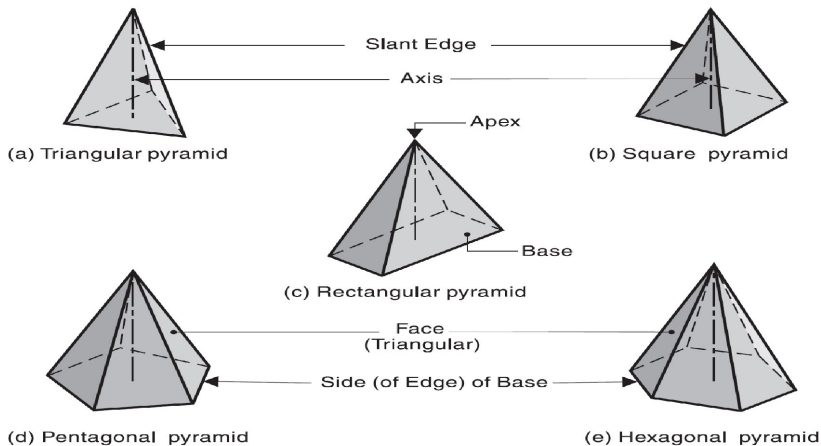

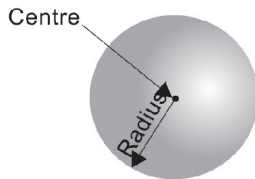
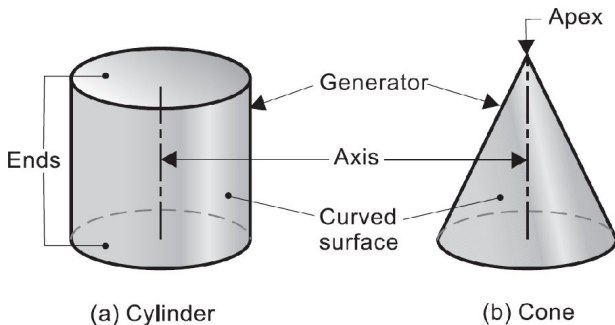

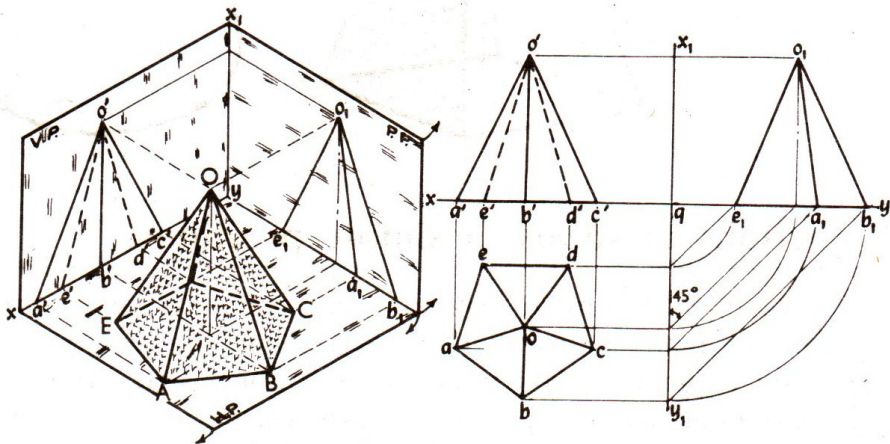

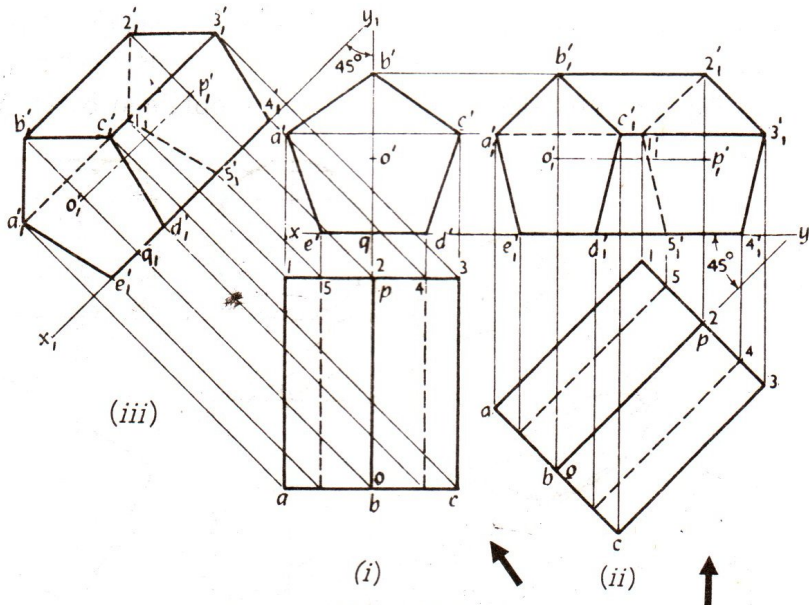

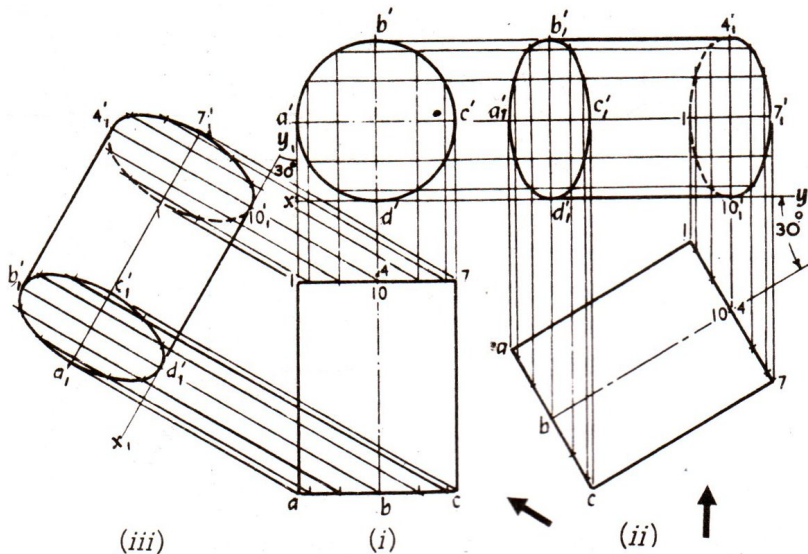
Simple position and side view



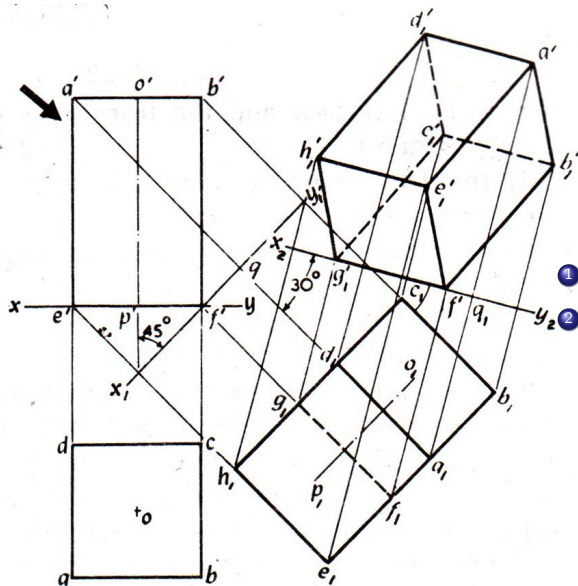
Axis inclined to VP and parallel to HP



Axis inclined to VP and parallel to HP

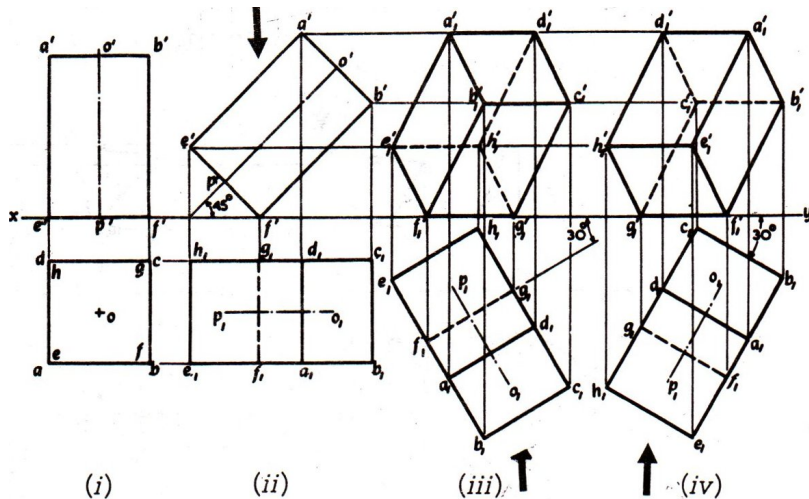


Axis inclined to both HP and VP



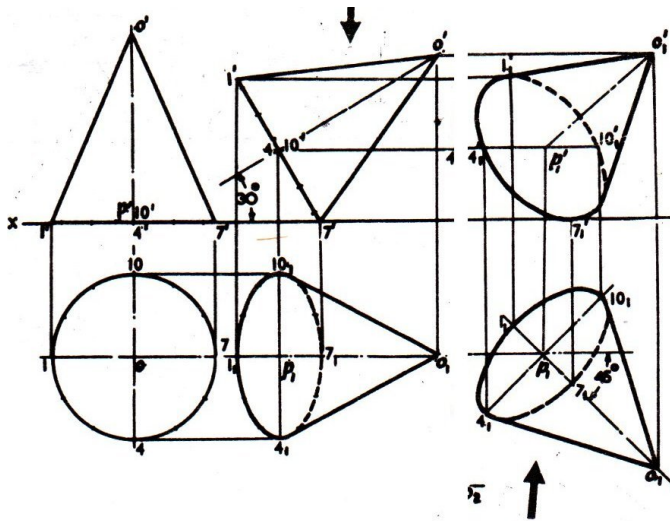
- ① Base = 40, ht = 65,

Axis inclined to both HP and VP

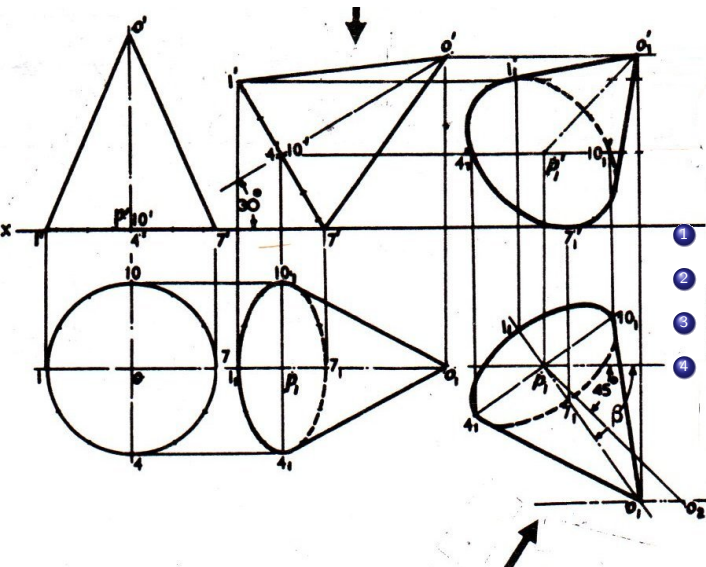


Axis inclined to both HP and VP
